When leaving

- Arrive at the airport at least **3 hours** before your scheduled departure and go through the security checkpoint as soon as you have completed your check-in formalities.
- Before leaving home, check your flight time.
- Reserve your parking spot online to speed up access when you arrive at the airport.
- Be sure you have all your travel documents with you: airline tickets, passport, visa, etc.
- Check the traffic situation at www.quebec511.info.

On your return

- To speed up your passage through customs:
 - Have your identification handy.
 - Fill in your customs declaration card completely.
- If you have arranged for someone to pick you up, ask them to wait in the CellParc lot. Parking there is free for two hours with free shuttle service every 15 minutes. To reach it from the terminal, go to Post 4 on the arrivals level and take the CellParc / P-9 shuttle.

- Wait until you pick up your baggage and have entered the public area before you call for transportation.
