

YUL MARKS THE FIRST DEPARTURE OF AN AIRBUS A220

Montréal, January 17, 2020 – The first commercial flight of an Airbus A220 aircraft took off from Montréal’s YUL airport yesterday morning. The first passengers travelling on this Air Canada-operated aircraft were welcomed with many surprises to mark this important event.

The A220 is equipped with state-of-the-art technology that saves fuel consumption per seat and reduces its noise footprint by 50% compared to previous generation aircraft.



“Québec is more than ever a reference in the aerospace sector. We are proud that the YMX International Aerocity of Mirabel is the assembly site for this next-generation aircraft. An impressive concentration of industry experts are working on our site and this aircraft underscores the talent of our local expertise.
