PUBLIC NOTICE FOR LIMOUSINE-SERVICE TAXI PERMIT OWNERS

Montréal, July 19, 2017 – Aéroports de Montréal (ADM) wishes to grant Airport “Limousine” Permits for Montréal–Pierre-Elliott-Trudeau International Airport (the “Airport”) valid for one (1) year and renewable from year to year unless otherwise stipulated, from November 1, 2017, and invites all limousine-service taxi permit owners to submit their candidacy in accordance with the following terms and conditions.

Conditions of eligibility (collectively, the “Conditions”)

Only candidates meeting the following conditions will be eligible:

1. Be the holder of a valid limousine-service taxi transportation permit issued by the Commission des Transports du Québec, and assigned for the territory of the Island of Montréal;
2. Be the holder of a valid identification sticker from the Bureau du Taxi de Montréal;
3. Satisfy the “General Conditions” and “Particular Conditions Applicable to Airport Limousine Permits,” available on the website of ADM <http://www.admtl.com/en/business/suppliers/taxis-limousines> beginning August 1, 2017;
4. Submit the following information by e-mail to transportcommercial@admtl.com:
 - a. Name (or business name), address in full, telephone number, e-mail address, CTQ permit number, BTM sticker number, licence plate number, plus vehicle make, model and year;
 - b. No later than 11:59 p.m. on August 13, 2017. No application will be accepted after 11:59 p.m. on August 13, 2017, regardless of the reason;

The candidate may submit only one (1) candidacy to obtain an Airport “Limousine” Permit (maximum one [1] permit per limousine-service taxi permit owner), under penalty of having all applications rejected;

5. Applicants must not have any outstanding account with ADM.

Selection

ADM will issue permits to the candidates who comply with the Conditions or provide proof that they will comply with them as of November 1, 2017.

Notwithstanding any provisions to the contrary, ADM reserves the right to:

- Disqualify a candidate who does not qualify under the “General Conditions” and “Particular Conditions”;
- Disqualify a candidate if more than one (1) application is submitted;
- Verify, with the authorities concerned, the validity of the information supplied by the candidate and reject any application form the content of which is inaccurate or incomplete;
- Cancel this public notice, at its sole discretion, without awarding any permit, compensation or indemnity of any kind;
- Reject any and all application forms;

- Request any other necessary information to evaluate the candidate; failure by a candidate to provide such information may result in their candidacy being rejected.
- Add limousine permits at any time.
