

PUBLIC NOTICE FOR REGULAR SERVICES TAXI PERMIT OWNERS

Montréal, July 29th 2015 – Aéroports de Montréal (“ADM”) wishes to grant three hundred and ten (310) Airport Taxi Permits in accordance with the following terms:

- Two hundred and two (202) “Regular” Airport Taxi Permits including seventy-seven (77) Mini-Van type vehicles, valid for one (1) year (from November 15, 2015 to November 14, 2016), and,
- One hundred and eight (108) “Green-Taxi” Airport Permits valid for one (1) year (from November 15, 2015 to November 14, 2016).

for the Montréal – Pierre Elliott Trudeau International Airport (the “Airport”) and invites all regular services taxi permit owners to submit their candidacy in accordance with the following terms and conditions.

Conditions of eligibility (collectively the “Conditions”):

Only candidates meeting the following conditions will be eligible:

1. To be the holder of a valid regular services taxi transportation permit issued by “Commission des Transports du Québec” and assigned for the territory of the Island of Montreal and more particularly for Area A-05: East of Montréal; Area A-11: Montréal; or Area A-12: West of Montréal.
2. Be the holder of a valid identification sticker for the “Bureau du taxi de Montréal”.
3. Satisfy the “General Conditions” and “Particular Conditions” governing the eligibility of the candidates, issued with the registration form which is available as of August 3, 2015 through August 14, 2015, at **Aéroports de Montréal, 975, Roméo-Vachon Nord – Room 303 (3rd floor), Dorval, Québec, H4Y 1H1** from Monday to Friday (8:00 to 4:00 PM).

The documents are available on ADM's website (<http://www.admtl.com/en/business/suppliers/taxis-limousine>), as of August 3, 2015.

4. To submit the duly completed application form, to **Aéroports de Montréal, 975, Roméo-Vachon Nord – Room 332 (3rd floor), Dorval, Québec, H4Y 1H1** on the above mentioned opening hours, **no later than August 14th 2015**. Registration forms not duly completed or received after August 14, 2015 at 4 PM will automatically be rejected, whatsoever the reason.

The candidate can submit only one (1) candidacy by area (maximum of one (1) permit by owner of regular services taxi permit by area) under penalty of having all his applications forms, related to this draw, cancelled.

5. Applicant cannot have any outstanding account with ADM.

Registration Costs:

Each candidate who wish to offer his candidacy following this public notice, must pay to ADM, with his inscription's deposition, registration fees of forty dollars (\$ 40.00), by credit card (MasterCard, Visa, Amex) or debit card when submitting his application form.

When registering, the candidate will apply for one (1) type of permit (Regular, Mini-Van or Green-taxi) depending of the eligibility criteria of each type. Ownership of a “Green” vehicle respecting the “Particular Conditions” and attached to his taxi permit is mandatory for applying for the “Green-Taxi” permit draw. The same condition applies for the minivan taxi permit draw; owner must have a Mini-Van respecting the “Particular Conditions” attached to his regular services taxi permit to participate in this draw.

Selection:

On September 2, 2015, under the supervision of an accounting firm, ADM will proceed with a draw for the issuance of three hundred and ten (310) Airport Taxi Permits valid from November 15, 2015 to November 14, 2016.

Note: For the Green-Taxis and Mini-Vans draws: In the event where candidacies exceed the number of permits available, the ones not drawn will be automatically put in the regular taxi permit draw.

The permits will be issued according to the following ratios:

Area	Regular	Green-Taxi	Mini-Van
A-05	17	14	10
A-11	87	76	54
A-12	21	18	13

The results of the draw will be posted on September 3, 2015 on the ADM website (admtl.com) and in the Taxis and Limousines basin.

Reservations:

Notwithstanding any provisions to the contrary, ADM reserves the right to:

- Disqualify a candidate in the event that the candidate do not qualify under the “Particular Conditions” and “General Conditions”.
- Disqualify a candidate if more than one (1) application by Area is submitted.
- Verify the validity of the information supplied by the candidate and to reject any application form where the contents is inaccurate or incomplete.
- Cancel this public notice at its sole discretion; without awarding any permit, compensation and indemnity of any kind.
- Deliver less than three hundred and ten (310) Airport Taxi Permits.
- Reject any and all applications forms.
- Request any other necessary information to evaluate the candidate. Failure for the candidate to provide the information requested may result in the candidate's reject.
