Montréal—Trudeau airport presents "Three decades of jazz in Montréal" photo exhibition

Montréal, March 29, 2010 - Aéroports de Montréal (ADM) is proud to present the *Three decades of jazz in Montréal* photo exhibition at Montréal–Trudeau airport.
