

## **PUBLIC NOTICE FOR ADAPTED TAXI OWNERS**

Aéroports de Montréal («ADM») wishes to grant a total of twelve (12) Airport Adapted Taxi Permits for the Montréal-Pierre Elliott Trudeau International Airport (the «Airport») for a period of five (5) years from February 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2006 to February 21<sup>st</sup>, 2011 ) and invites all taxi owners to submit their candidacy, the whole in accordance with the following terms and conditions.

### **1) Conditions of Eligibility (collectively the « Conditions »):**

Only candidates meeting the following conditions will be eligible:

- Be the holder of a valid taxi transportation permit issued by “Commission des Transports du Québec” assign for the territory of the island of Montreal.
- Complete application form which will be available and remitted by ADM with the “Particular Conditions” **(Particular Conditions Applicable to Airport Adapted Taxi Permits, effective February 22, 2006 to February 21, 2011)** as of Monday, January 9<sup>th</sup>, 2006 at the Control booth located in the Commercial Vehicle lot at the Airport (open Monday to Sunday from 6:30 A.M. to 01:30 A.M.).
- Duly completed application form must be received at the ADM's office located in the Terminal Building, room 327, no later than Wednesday, January 18<sup>th</sup>, 2006 at 3:30 P.M. Business hours are from Monday to Friday from 9:30 A.M to 11:30 A.M. and 1:30 P.M. to 3:30 P.M. No application forms will be accepted after **Wednesday, January 18<sup>th</sup>, 2006 at 3:30 P.M.** for any reason whatsoever.
- must submit only one (1) application form (maximum of one (1) permit for each taxi owner).
- must not have any outstanding account with ADM.
- must comply with and meet all other criteria of eligibility more fully described in the “Particular Conditions” as above-mentioned available with the application form.

### **2) Registration Costs:**

Each candidate must pay to ADM application fees of ten dollars (\$10.00), by cash or credit card only, with the application form.

### **3) Selection of candidates:**

At the end of January 2006, a random draw establishing a sequence of candidates shall be performed by ADM among the application forms duly completed and received by ADM within the prescribed time period. Following the random draw, ADM will verify and check the eligibility of the candidates in accordance with the Conditions indicated in paragraph 1 above. Following this evaluation and verification, ADM will issue Twelve (12) Airport “Adapted Taxi” Permits, in accordance with the following ratio: Two (2) permits for Agglomeration A-5; eight (8) permits for Agglomeration A-11; and two (2) permits for Agglomeration A-12. The Permits so issued shall be valid for a period of five (5) years, being from

February 22nd, 2006 until February 21st, 2011, without any renewal and subject to all Conditions indicated in paragraph 1 above.

#### **4) Reservations:**

Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, ADM reserves the right to:

- Disqualify a candidate in the event that its application form does not contain the necessary information to permit a thorough analysis;
- Verify the validity of the information supplied by the candidate and to reject any application form where the contents is inaccurate or incomplete;
- Award less than twelve (12) Adapted Taxi Permits;
- In it's sole and absolute discretion, cancel this public notice without award or compensation or indemnity whatsoever to the applicants;
- Reject any and all application forms;
- Request any other necessary information to evaluate the candidate. Failure for the candidate to provide the information requested may result in the application form being rejected.
